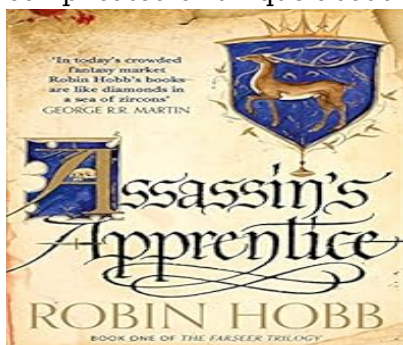


Epub Assassin's apprenticeship
