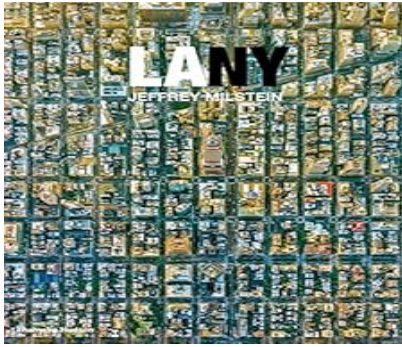


LA NY : Aerial Photographs of Los Angeles and New York : Milstein, Jeffrey By Jeffrey Milstein
