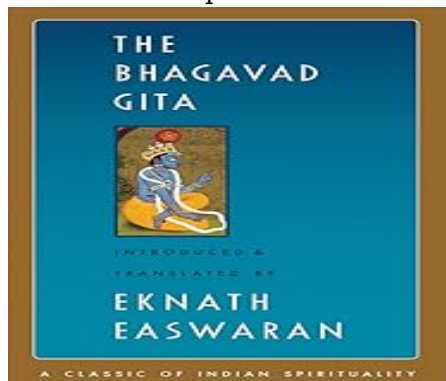


## The Bhagavad Gita: 1 By Eknath Easwaran

Kindle Pasta dura Pasta blanda Eknath eswaran's translation and explanations of the Gita align to the Mahatma Gandhi philosophy of ahimsa and dharma, It is in that sense a slightly weighted form of understanding that he derives which may be disputed by some scholars: Certainly there are some concepts of caste and devotion that do not ring true to me but then I am in no position to judge: All in all this version of Gita is simple enough to understand and it reads true for most part, The authors tone is what I like the most humble and exploratory and open to dialogue for we are all errant explorers grasping at glimpses of the truth. Meditation is also an essential part of gaining understanding. Warm wishes to all on this path. And the reason is clear. My admiration of the man and his works is boundless.
