The second half of the book focuses on explaining why Israel supports many groups that on first glance seem far removed from being of any concern of Israel or even in conflicted with the interest of the nation. Strong conclusion demonstrating that support for these groups is far from an aberration of some earlier form of Zionism but a direct result of an ideology that justifies a colonial project as international colonialism collapses: This book deals with the Israeli relationship with those countries which do not recognize Israel or ideologically at odds with her.
