Marriage for a HEA for her father and sister is a hard concept to consider but you do sympathise with Addie and honestly she has no way to achieve this and let her sister have the future she never had by selling her soul and life to the Devil. I really cannot wait for part three and although this book does end on a cliff hanger it's reasonably mild and I suspect that the final book will cement the relationship between Addie and Daimon and sharpen a lot of the blurred lines. I cannot wait to find out how this series finishes and although Daimon is a proper prize asshole.

Chick Lit Making a deal with the devil is never a good idea no matter how good the deal is. I loved it go Addie! Addie is only in this to see that her little sister gets the chance she deserves at going to collage and making a life for herself and in the end Addie is dept free or is she? Secrets have a way of coming out and neither side is free of them when both Daimon and Addie discover the secrets that lie between them there just maybe hope for Addie yet. I'm marrying the man I despise the man that as much as I try not to be I'm drawn to; lost in his power over me lost in this indescribable feeling that is between us. Can Addie fight the bond they are now creating? Or will Addie give into the devil she calls Daimon? Daimon has his demons that lurk behind his calm and ruthless veneer what will Addie do when she finally sees them for herself? Note from the Author: This is a dysfunctional love and hate trilogy that involves emotional blackmail and a few other situations that the one wouldn't do to the person they liked or loved. Slithers of understanding and his reasons why come to light and then he goes and does another stupid ass move and what you're beginning to like about him gets shot to pieces again and I love that! Addie grows stronger through this book but it's her constant doubt and her not dealing with things properly that had me almost screaming at her sometimes. Some of the latter book scenarios didn't flow as good as book one the scene with Linda well that didn't impress me at all very little substance to it and had me thinking it wasn't worth the air time gutted I have to wait as my co-reviewer mentioned both us hate waiting in between books especially up to six months. I would like to say there was much more sex in this book and I worry that book 3 might become a sexfest of epic proportions going by the title please Evangelene sate my need for a great plot and fab storyline coupled only with a generous sprinkling of bedroom antics. the story goes pretty fast although nothing really is happening considering the plot action there's banter a lot of messed up converstation (I frequently had to go back to re-read the lines cause I was like) wait what?! which was pretty exausting at times. they thrive towards the mental torture it's like they grow into each other by mind fuck mood swings and whiplash tantrums after which they fall into a hot angry passionate tangle between the sheets or against the wall or the shower. well news flash you are BOTH scary! You messed up twisted people you! Daimon Evans no matter how good he looks she (Addie) calls him Lucifer (which awfully reminds me of another series featuring a certain gent called by the same name well a version of it - the Devil) well same shit! now this guy I have no real opinion of him BUT i think he's a fucked up asshole! Daimon might seem cold and unfeeling but deep down he's loving and caring. He's thirty years old for fuck's sake!!! Anyway his actions are completely opposite of reason! He's like bipolar still no I don't think so it would be too medical he's just emotionally imbalanced and immature! BUT he loves Addie in his own twisted possessive and clingy obsessive way! Addie in this book goes through a complete change. Addie does mature a bit throughout the story but her indisputable lack of self esteem and self worth puts her in situations where her emotions overrule any common sense and its NOW easy to feel sorry for her. She finally tries to make her own path realizing the benefits of being married to a billionaire but revelations about who Daimon is and his manipulations interfere with Addie's plans. I did enjoy how things changed because honestly what's the point of reading about two people who hate each other so deeply if not to hope for a change in what they are to each other. By the end of this part of the story I'm not sure I'm rooting for them to be together even if they have figured out and embrace that the near constant bickering is just them. The Husband Beside Me book 2 in a trilogy ends with a great

cliffhanger that could go in so many directions and I have no doubt that author could deliver portions of these scenarios in one book. She has no redeeming qualities & whether you sell yourself to save the entire world or not that still makes you a prostitute & for her to use her husband's lack of common sense in some areas to continuously hammer him the entire book is mind bending. Addie want the best for her family and has run herself into the ground trying to accomplish this and is the cornered like a terrified Rabbit into marrying the tornado that is Daimon I'm still rooting for him! A big drama was made but sizzled out far too quickly and almost brushed under the carpet, I am sorry to say this is a cliffhanger that really doesn't leave me panting at the bit: I wanted to kick Addie up the arse! It's funny I think the two scenarios could have been changed around and the cliffhanger done differently, This to me was a cliffie that yes has you wondering but doesn't have you gouging your eyes out in frustration, So on a cliffie headache scale this is gentle in my opinion, All I can say is woman you sold yourself to the highest bidder, The book would have been a better read from Daimon's perspective or maybe not than I would have had to watch this crazy female abusing his mind. Maybe he needs abusing after all just for his questionable judgment in purchasing a shrew. Daimon didn't disappoint in the ass hole stakes yet again and the dialogue and back and forth hostility from Addie really made the first half of the book for me, Then the girl grows a set of balls and starts to fight back, But with the anger comes passion and the dynamic and relationship between the two really skyrockets. This makes for a really gripping read and when Addie turns the story really gets momentum. Addie marries Daimon Evens with a contract that neither can brake or their fate is sealed: Daimon is not the type of guy to be messed with he is a snake that lingers waiting to strike, He releases his venom on Addie and constantly try's to humiliate her at every turn, This man made my skin crawl I wanted to punch him in the face! Then there is a change and Addie unleashes a venom all her own that catches Daimon off guard: It wound me up so tight and the the cord was released and my head was spinning and I was left with a cliff hanger ending: Evangelene has another awesome book under her and I am left saying please bring out the next book so I can have the answers I seek: The Husband Beside Me is a book that just took me through an obstacle course and left me fighting for a breath. I ask myself over and over again, BUT we follow the up and downs of both characters while they mess each other up through and through: repeat it all over again! And after they confess their love to each other they state as well: You scare me: and I am not quite sure I like it I mean she's still strong BUT she's caved into him her attraction towards Daimon took its toll on her and she gave into the feelings: she admitted to love him back from hate to love sure there's really a thin thin line there. and then she flips in the end of the book over the fact that he LIED(!) to her about the reasons he stated during his first proposition he gave her in book 1, I mean really?! like she needed THAT little thing to make the final act? c'mon?! ok to wrap it up it's like I would combine the parts of Lady GaGa's song BAD ROMANCE really. I want your love I want your drama The touch of your hand I want your leather-studded kiss in the sand, You can say that again! Uf I don't know what to say you might think I didn't like the book LOL but I did! Strangely as it sounds I did. Naw she really doesn't do a very good job hiding her true feelings from Daimon or us: As Addie and Daimon take the next step in fulfilling their agreement the reasons behind the contract may not be what we are led to believe. These two are so alike and the sheer strength of their emotions will be their demise. Where I kinda liked Daimon in The Devil Behind Me he's become the bully that Addie knew him as in high-school and he's taken it to a new extreme, He gets more and more mean with cruel words and equally cruel actions and at times it's hard to get past all the negative but it's innate to who they are, Addie continues to be spiteful which seems to egg Daimon on. As we saw near the end of The Devil Behind Me Daimon is now spouting near constant words of hate: However there is a new element in the mix in that Addie learns that Daimon's life is not what she thought. Now we know why he's so manically mean but it doesn't excuse his behavior in the least: But for Addie understanding brings out her feelings of sympathy and confusion that leave her vulnerable, The story takes place over a period of about a year with an evolution of Addie and Daimon's relationship: They have chemistry and don't fight off the need but it's not wrought out of love and is very much a pheromonal response to each other: The change in feelings comes later and they finally begin to treat each other with some respect and try to enjoy time together, It's almost like watching a terrible accident - you just can't help yourself and you hope that everyone involved survives, This is a 4 star read for me and I do recommend this series: The author sets out to deliver a story that shows two people in a different type of hate/love and ultimately a lust filled relationship: Fantasy Romance Chick Lit Wow Addie the lead female in this series has got to be one of the most irritating women ever created in modern literature. I'm not even married to her & the few hours I spent in her thoughts were excruciating (and that poor man actually bought her: All I remember of her is 'I'm leaving you Daimon you LIED: He did not cheat murder Romance Chick Lit



I must admit after reading *The Devil Behind Me* I had mixed feelings about delving into this book. The concept behind Addie and Daimon deciding to marry was very unique. Yep good luck with that! In principle seems simple enough but not when you are dealing with someone as wicked as Daimon: He doesn't waste an opportunity to put her down or embarrass her: He seems to enjoy hurting her not physically but he is torturing her soul, He spend most of the book spitting venom towards Addie but finally the worm turns and snarls back at him like a fierce tigress. The characters have stayed true and have grown in a naturally progressive way as people do over time: oh how I hate cliffhangers and how I hate them even more when I have to wait 6 months for the final book of a trilogy, I almost wish I hadn't read them yet if I hadn't I wouldn't have felt the emotional turmoil that this author has managed to throw at me. 5 Stars! Throughout the first half of this book Daimon is an ass of the highest degree with some of the stunts he attempts to pull on Addie: But there are also moments that occur where we get to actually see a Daimon who is thoughtful and perhaps considerate of Addie's feelings: But then he'll open his mouth and ruin the moment and you might have the urge to punch him in the throat.
