This is the only Star Wars book I read as a kid--as much as I had a Star Wars Thing for a year or two in middle school I had very little sense of what was out there or that I could read it. **Star wars mystery pin** It's not terrible even if the concept is kind of silly; it's a diary book where the main character doesn't really have time to make some of the diary entries and they don't really read like dictation so much as plain old first-person narrative. **Rogue one a star wars story epub** But it's fun to get a (now thoroughly decanonized) look at the mission to get the Death Star plans as well as an escape attempt from the Death Star before Luke and Han show up. **Star wars visions** At only 18 a princess and a senator she had already been recruiting members for the Rebellion running weapons and smuggling supplies and in general wreaking havoc for the Empire! Grief frightened me. **Star wars dark disciple epub download** If that rumor of Obi-Wan being a hermit (possibly with the location of Tatooine attached) was floating around how was he not being hunted down by Vader and the Empire? Unless that information was passed onto Leia from Bail in the guise of a rumor it doesn't make much sense. **Star wars books in order** I'd picked it up hoping to learn new insights into Leia's character and her contributions to the rebellion prior to the start of the main trilogy- but alas I was somewhat disappointed. **Book star wars galactic starcruiser** While her audio journal does recount some of the facts surrounding her backstory and time spent on the Death Star prior to rescue 70% of the story is simply recounting the film as it transpired. **Star wars visions** I was however impressed by some of the difficult topics that Jude Watson was able to cram into a children's book which may presumably be part of the reason why it was a little tricky to find. **Star wars wallpaper kindle fire** Star Wars: JournalCaptive to Evil This is honestly one of the best Leia centric books I've ever read and it's partially because she's ready to bite someone's head off the entire book:

She escapes her cell briefly in Entry 8.But finding General Kenobi isn't my biggest problem. Convincing him to join the Rebellion is. But I will do it. I know how to do this. I've been taught this too.Wait. So. suicide basically?The writing was blunt and juvenile. Original. I liked her before this but now I'm a big fan. The writing was also a lot better.
