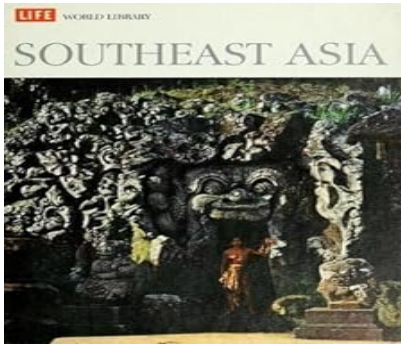


Southeast Asia (LIFE World Library) By Stanley Karnow
