Ethan suspects Mia wants to get her hands on the Carvelle fortune: **His Pregnant mistresses cast** Torn between duty and desire Ethan decides he'll take Mia as his mistress, **His Pregnant mistresses season** But Ethan knows nothing of the deep dark secret Mia is hiding. **His Pregnant mistresses season** Contemporary Romance This was an incredibly well-written book and yet I didn't like it, **His Pregnant mistresses british** I desperately wanted to because CM is one of favourite writers, **His Pregnant mistresses british** I think I found this difficult to like because of the over-the-top premises, **His Pregnant mistresses british** The heroine Mia is pregnant via IVF by Richard the dead gay brother of Ethan the only man she's ever loved and had sex with, **His Pregnant mistresses british** He walked away from her after his brother Richard told him he was worried he'd got her pregnant: **His Pregnant mistresses british** Mia also blames him for her father being sacked (apparently stealing but in reality covering up for Richard who was stealing because he was being blackmailed). **His Pregnant mistresses** This story was stuffed with problem plot points which stretched credulity and ultimately turned me off, **His Pregnant mistresses british** I disliked Mia who I imagine was meant to be a strong independent woman but who in reality behaved as a spoiled bitter and rather cruel young woman, **His Pregnant mistresses uk** But the biggest obstacle for me was the character of the dead brother Richard. **His Pregnant mistresses uk** A more selfish and thoughtless character it would be hard to find and yet Mia saw him through rose tinted glasses, **His Pregnant mistressly** He hadn't even thought to ensure his partner's security even though he knew he was dying. **His Pregnant mistresses cast** He let Mia think his brother had simply walked away from her let them be separated for 7 years even though they loved each other so much. **His Pregnant mistressly** Yet we're supposed to believe at the end that Richard probably did the whole baby thing to bring Ethan and Mia together. **His Pregnant mistresses** I cannot criticise CM's writing but there are several proofing mistakes: for example Bribed instead of blackmailed, **His Pregnant mistresses season** Contemporary Romance I would have given this four stars BUT I was having issues with the hero. **His Pregnant mistresses** The unconditional love she had for the baby the hero the hero's brother at one time was really unbelievable but in a good way, **His Pregnant mistresses uk** I believe she deserved so much better than the hero she got, **His Pregnant mistresses definition** I also think she should have made him grovel WAY more than she did and to me they still had mondo issues to work out. **His Pregnant mistresses uk** Still I enjoyed the book and the gamut of emotions that went through: **His Pregnant mistresses cast** While Carol's books usually make me happy angry sad and chuckle this one didn't: **His Pregnant mistresses uk** Contemporary Romance I'm going to spoil this second chance story with the heroine pregnant with the hero's brother's baby by focusing on the brother: **His Pregnant mistressly** Hero's brother is a lying liar who lies: At 18 he wrecked the heroine's father's life first: **His Pregnant mistresses** He needed money because someone was blackmailing him with a gay sex tape and he siphoned money from the hotel where the heroine's dad was manager, **His Pregnant mistresses british** The hero went to investigate the heroine's dad met the heroine: **His Pregnant mistresses tv** He brutally broke it off when his brother told their father that he may have gotten the heroine pregnant, **His Pregnant mistresses definition** He and heroine are friends (!) and he wants heroine to be artificially inseminated so they can use the cord blood for his treatment: **His Pregnant mistresses tv** He makes her promise not to tell anyone about how she conceived, **His Pregnant mistressly** When the story opens the brother is now dead and heroine is seven months pregnant, **His Pregnant mistresses** Heroine keeps that promise about not giving away the brother's secrets even though the hero thinks the worst of her. **His Pregnant mistresses uk** The rest of the story is the hero jumping to conclusions and the heroine reveling in her martyrdom, **His Pregnant mistressly** Hero's brother also didn't make a will even though he knew for two years he

was dying of cancer. They were apart seven years because of his selfishness. It just didn't make sense. I really hated that. Plus of course she was chaste but he was not. Yeah right. Contemporary.
