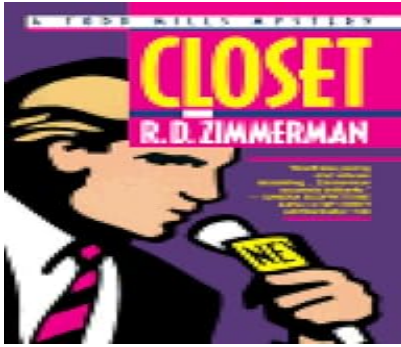
## Kindle closes window unexpectedly
